What an incredible year it has been for the Community Resource Center (CRC)! I am deeply grateful for your continued commitment to the families we serve. That commitment was most evident in our fundraising efforts, highlighted by our inaugural Welcome Home Gala, which raised an inspiring \$130,000. Thanks to your generosity, we were able to increase our rental assistance maximum and provide support to more families than ever before.

Over the past year, we've also taken important steps to strengthen our continuum of care. By building new partnerships and relocating our family shelter, we positioned ourselves to serve more families with greater flexibility. We also expanded our housing options by adding two transitional living homes and a rental subsidy program—closing a long-standing gap in transitional housing. Our Family Shelter in Hugo is in the process of transforming into one of these new transitional homes, while our sheltering program has become more adaptive, operating across multiple sites in Washington County.

Looking ahead, we are committed to deepening and solidifying this continuum of care. Our focus will be on strengthening the sheltering program through intensive case management and wraparound services, ensuring families not only find safety but also stability and hope for the future. We will continue to listen, adapt, and respond to the growing needs of our community with compassion and determination.

The needs in our community remain great and the numbers speak for themselves. That's why your continued partnership is vital. Whether through your time, resources, or prayer, your support empowers us to grow together and create lasting impact for the families we serve.

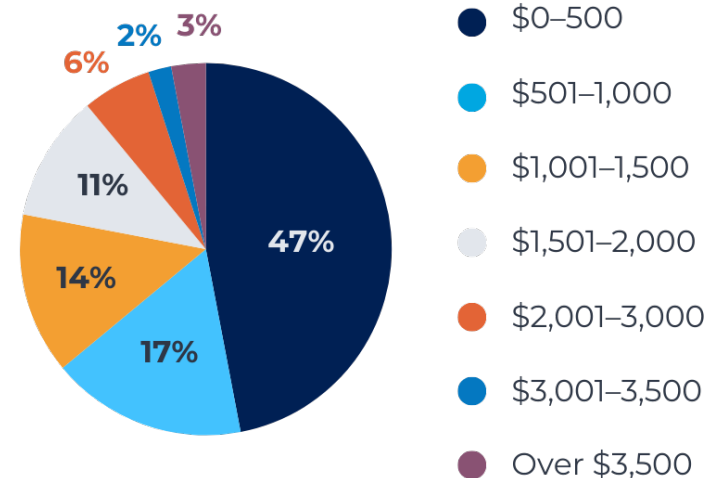

FINANCIAL DEMOGRAPHICS OF FAMILIES SERVED IN 2024-25 FISCAL YEAR

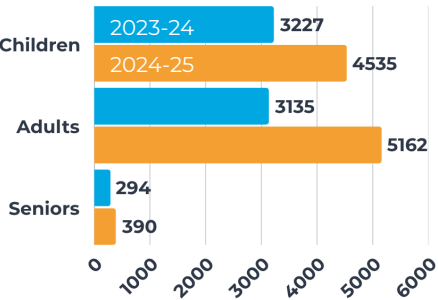
Monthly Income of Guests



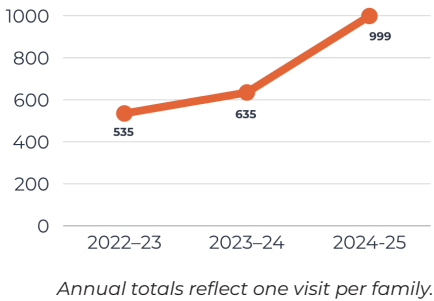
FOOD MARKET & CLOTHESLINE SHOPPING

All items in our food pantry (Food Market) and clothing, shoes, and accessories store (Clothesline) are free to our CRC guests.

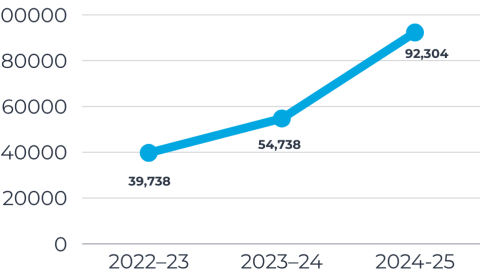
Total Guests Served



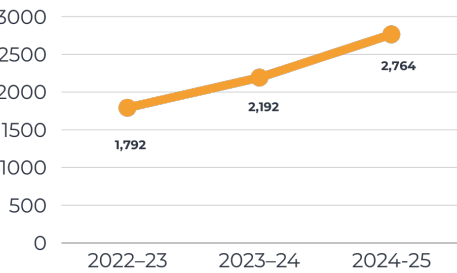
Total Families Served



Total Pounds of Food



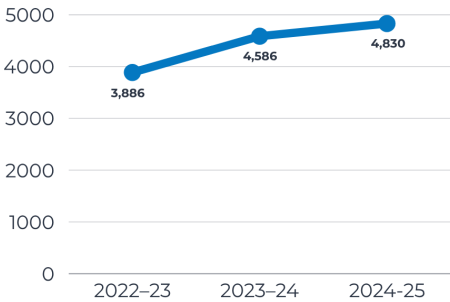
Total Food Market Visits

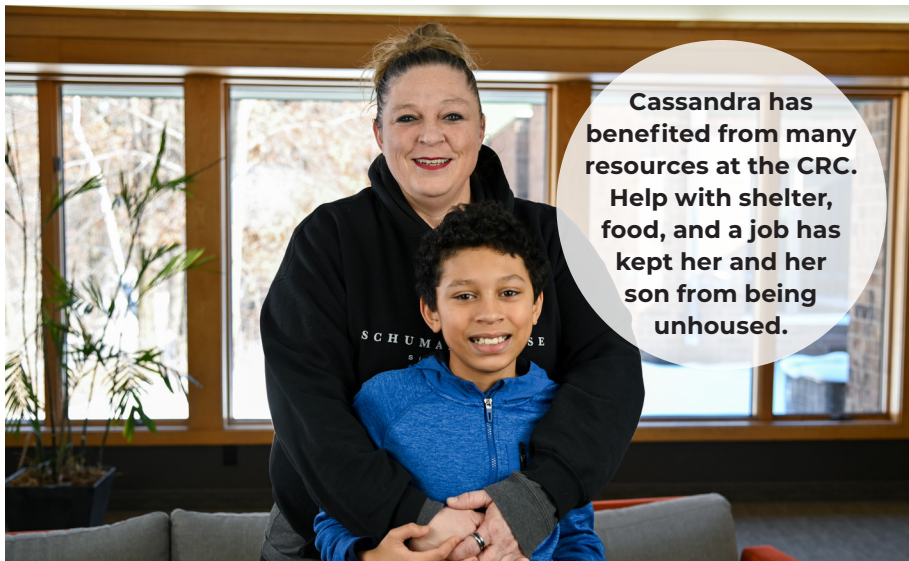
Financial Gifts
